

GRAPELAND NOON LIONS CLUB Scholarship Guidelines

- 1 Student applicants must be graduating seniors of Grapeland High School or of an accredited home school program. Students must live within the Grapeland Independent School District. Proof of residence must be provided. Home-schooled applicants must provide proof of accreditation of their home school program.
- 2 Applications may be obtained at the GISD school counselor's office and must be returned along with required supporting documentation before April 15th of the current school year.
- 3 Applications will be reviewed by a committee composed of Lions Club members in good standing and appointed by the current president of the club. The Scholarship Committee will review all applications and will determine eligible submissions. These recommended applicants will be presented for vote by the membership present at the next regularly scheduled meeting.
- 4 Scholarship certificates for the awarded value will be presented to the recipient at a time and place selected by the Lions Club near the end of the school year.
- 5 Scholarship winners must register at a college or technical school of their choosing, then provide proof of enrollment to the current Lions Club treasurer, who will disburse the financial award.

The Grapeland Noon Lions Club is now accepting applications for scholarships up to \$500.00. The application and supporting documents must be received by the Lions Club no later than the APRIL 15th deadline.

Criteria for Selection:

- Applicant must submit a properly completed application package (see attached)
- Applicant must be a graduating senior of Grapeland High School or a home-schooled senior living within the Grapeland Independent School District (please provide proof of residence) (home-schooled applicants must also provide proof of accreditation of their home school program)
- Moral character
- Community service and/or participation in civic groups
- Academic standing
- Need

Applicants must be “full time students” as defined by the school in which s/he is enrolled.

Scholarships will be paid to the student upon receipt of college expense documentation.
